✓ Candidates are requested to put ID number of any Govt. issued I.D. Card (like PAN / AADHAAR/ Voter Card) at the time of online submission of application and produce the original document at the time of Written Examination & Viva Voce, whenever asked.

How to Apply

- Candidates are required to apply online using the website https://coochbeharwb.in.
- After online submission of the application, the applicant shall have to submit a print out of the same along with all relevant documents at the Office of the CDPO Haldibari ICDS Project within 17/04/2023 upto 5.30PM.
- Any applications submitted online only but not submitted thereafter along with necessary documents in hard copy to the CDPO Haldibari ICDS Project shall summarily be rejected.
- Detailed instructions for filling up online applications are available on the above mentioned website.
- The applicants are advised to submit only single application. However, if due to any unavoidable situation, if an applicant submits another/multiple applications, then the applicant must ensure that application with the latest i.e. last applied Registration ID (RID) is complete in all respects like applicants' details, etc. The applicants who are submitting multiple applications should note that only the applications with latest RID only shall be entertained by the Office. 1) FOR THE POST OF ANGANWADI WORKERS (AWW)

1.1 Eligibility Conditions:

a) Residence: The candidate applying for the said post must be the a permanent resident of the Haldibari ICDS Project area consisting of 6(Six) Gram Panchayet and one Munici[pality(Haldibari). The Candidate residing in these GPs are eligible for the post of AWWs considering the Project as unit. If selected, a candidate can be posted in an AWC under any of these GPs.

Note: Residential Certificate issued either by the concerned MP/ Sabhadhipati/ MLA/ Sabhapati, Panchayat Samiti/ Pradhan-Gram Panchayat or the concerned District Magistrate/ Addl. District Magistrate/ SDO/ BDO will be accepted. Name of Gram Panchayat must be mentioned clearly in Residential Certificate if it is issued by any authority other than Gram Panchayat Pradhan and it should be produced as and when asked for.

- b) Age Limit: The candidate must be in the Age Limit of 18-45 years as on 01/01/2023 for all categories i.e. UR/ SC/ ST/ OBC-A/ OBC-B/ PH candidates. The Candidate must have been born not earlier than 01/01/1978 and not later than 01/01/2005. Candidates should also note that once a date of birth has been submitted by them in the Application Form for the purpose of admission to this Examination, no change will be allowed subsequently on any grounds whatsoever. Admit Card of Madhyamik Examination / Madhyamik Pass Certificate / Birth Certificate will be accepted as Age Proof of the candidate.
- c) Minimum Educational Qualification: The applicant must have passed minimum Class-X equivalant from a recognised Board for all categories i.e. UR/ SC/ ST/ OBC-A/ OBC-B/ PH candidates. The above noted qualification must be possessed by the candidate on or before 17/04/2023.

d) Reservation:-

- Reservation will be maintained as per 100 Points Roster for SC/ST/OBC-A/OBC-B/ PH candidates.
- ii. Caste Certificate issued only by the Sub-Divisional Officer having jurisdiction under the Government of West Bengal will be accepted. Else the candidate will not be treated as Candidate applying under any Reserved Category. Caste Certificate must be valid in respect of the State of West Bengal and issued on or before 17/04/2023.
- iii. Disability Certificate (with 40 % and above) issued by the competent medical board (Medical College/ District Hospital/ Subdivisional Hospital) will be accepted if it is issued on or before 17/04/2023. Else the candidate will not be treated as Candidate applying under any Reserved Category.

Name of Gram Panchayat must be mentioned clearly in Residential Certificate if it is issued by any authority other than Gram Panchayat Pradham and it should be made to be accepted for

Panchayat Pradhan and it should be produced as and when asked for.

b) Age Limit: The candidate must be in the age limit of 18-45 years as on 01/01/2023 for all categories i.e. UR/ SC/ ST/ OBC-A/ OBC-B/ PH candidates. The Candidate must have been born not early than 01/01/1978 and not later than 01/01/2005. Candidates should also note that once a date of birth has been submitted by them in the Application Form for the purpose of admission to this Examination, no change will be allowed subsequently on any grounds whatsoever. Admit Card of Madhyamik Examination / Madhyamik Pass Certificate / Birth Certificate will be accepted as Age Proof of the candidate.

c) Minimum Educational Qualification: The applicant must have passed minimum Class-VIII equivalant from a recognised Board for all categories i.e. UR/ SC/ ST/ OBC-A/ OBC-B/ PH candidates. The above noted qualification must be possessed by the candidate on or before 17/04/2023.

d) Reservation:-

- Reservation will be maintained as per 100 points Roster for SC/ ST/ OBC-A/ OBC-B/ PH candidates.
